## PLAN YOUR VACCINE.

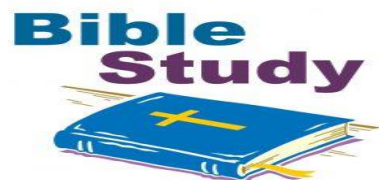

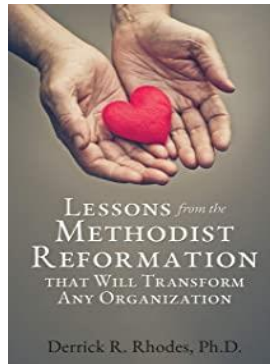

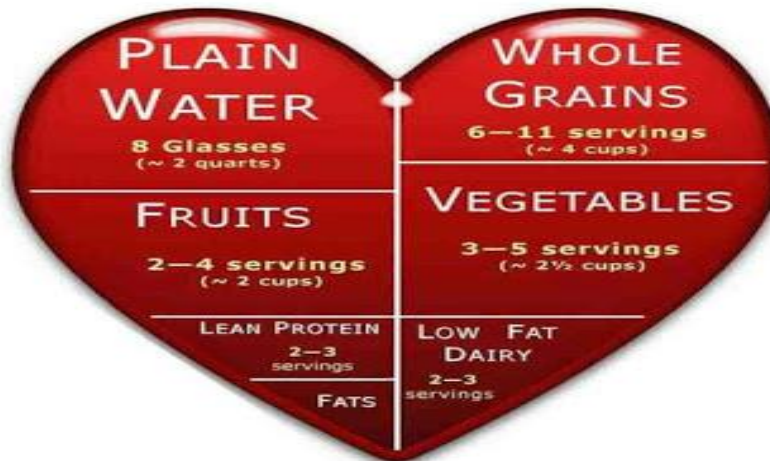

### Illness and Bereavement Guidelines for Members

For an official response from Kelley Chapel UMC...

1. The church member or immediate family member personally calls **Dr Rhodes at 770-774-8830** and notifies him of the situation.
  - **Illness/Hospitalization of members**
    - The Senior Pastor and/or his designee will provide prayer/encouragement and/or visitation, as possible.

- **Deaths of members, member's spouse, children, siblings, or parents**
  - The Senior Pastor will notify the Bereavement committee to send condolences from the church. Members can send personal condolences, but personal condolences should not be sent from KCUMC ministries. The Kelley Chapel UMC Bereavement committee will respond with condolences on behalf of the whole church.
  - The church member or immediate family member provides Dr Rhodes with pertinent information, including full name and hospital, if applicable, and funeral arrangements, when available.

2. The church member or immediate family member provides Dr. Rhodes the name of the contact person and phone number for follow-up.
